

Tomar staunchly defends new farm Laws in upper house

Oppn claims barricades are akin to 'Berlin Wall'

New Delhi, Feb. 6: Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar on Friday asserted that the government's offer to amend the new farm laws to assuage farmers' sentiments did not mean they had any flaws even as opposition parties demanded fresh legislations with one Congress MP describing the acts as "death warrants" for farmers.

Putting up a vigorous defence of the three new agri laws in the Rajya Sabha in the face of a strident demand for their repeal and continuing protests by farmers, Tomar also said none from the protesting unions or their sympathisers have been able to point out any lacuna. Those opposing the farm laws are not willing to say what is black in these 'black laws' as termed by them for the government try to rectify it, he added.

Several opposition

members while demanding fresh laws after consultations also raised the issue of new fortifications at the sites of protests by farmers at the Delhi borders.

Congress leader Pratap Singh Bajwa, who said the farm laws were like "death warrants" for farmers, compared the barricades with the Berlin Wall that had divided the German city's east and west and concentration camps. Intervening in the debate on the motion of thanks on the President's address, Tomar countered the claim by the Congress and other opposition parties that farmers across the country are agitated over the three laws, saying peasants of just one state are being misinformed and instigated.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi, who will reply to the debate on Monday after Zero hour, lauded Tomar's

remarks, saying he has given detailed information on every aspect of the legislations.

In a tweet, Modi posted a video link to Tomar's statement and said it is his humble request that people hear his speech. Tomar said the Opposition parties criticised the government and even termed the three legislations as "kala kanun" (black law).

"For two months I kept asking farmer unions what is 'kala' in the laws so that I can try to rectify. But I could not get the answer," Tomar, along with two other union ministers, has held 11 meetings with leaders of the farmer unions in the wake of the over two-month-long protests but the deadlock has continued. Separately, Tomar said in a written reply that the Centre followed "due procedure" before bringing the three new agri laws, and held

consultations with states and farmers for facilitating barrier-free trade in farm produce to provide choice to the farming community.

"Due procedure had been followed while formulating the Ordinances/ Bills." K.C. Venugopal from Congress and Binoy Viswam from CPI had asked the government to share the pre-legislative consultations followed before bringing the three farm laws and also the number of individuals/organisations/ unions consulted for the same.

Citing reasons for "urgency" to promulgate the three Ordinances in June 2020, Tomar said due to disruption of markets and supply chains during the COVID-19 lockdown, there was "utmost need to allow free direct marketing outside the mandis to facilitate the farmers in selling their produce near to farm gate at remunerative prices."

Ready to work with China on America's interest: Biden

Washington/ Beijing, Feb. 6: Describing an "aggressive" China as the "most serious competitor" to the US, President Joe Biden has said that his administration will take on the challenges posed by Beijing directly, but will not hesitate to work with it when it is in America's interest to do so.

Realising that a rising and more assertive China as one of his biggest foreign policy challenges, Biden on Thursday stressed the importance of allies in responding to the strategic competition

posed by Beijing. "We will confront China's economic abuses, counter its aggressive, coercive action to push back on China's attack on human rights, intellectual property and global governance," Biden said in his address to State Department employees at its Foggy Bottom headquarters here.

"We will also take on directly the challenges posed by our prosperity, security, and democratic values by our most serious competitor, China," he said.

The China-US relationship is crucial to

both sides, and the world. Tensions have soared in recent times, over trade, espionage and the coronavirus pandemic.

Washington and Beijing have also sparred over espionage, China's military build-up in the South China Sea and the mass detention of Uyghur Muslims in Xinjiang.

Biden, a Democrat, said his administration is ready to work with China when it is in America's interest to do so.

In Beijing, the Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesman gave a muted response Biden's twin policy approach

of confrontation with China on challenges it posed and cooperation to further American interests, saying both countries can achieve "big things" together and their common interests far outweigh their differences.

"As two major countries China and the US share broad common interests and special major responsibilities for upholding world peace stability and prosperity," foreign ministry spokesman Wang Wenbin told a media briefing on Friday.

ISRO to launch Brazilian sat, 20 other payloads on Feb 28

Bengaluru, Feb. 6: In its first space mission in 2021, India's space agency ISRO planned to launch Brazilian satellite Amazonia-1 and 20 other payloads, including one built by a home-grown start-up, on February 28.

The launch from Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC) SHAR, Sriharikota, is tentatively scheduled at 10.23 am, subject to weather conditions,

Bengaluru-headquartered Indian Space Research Organisation said on Friday.

PSLV-C51/ Amazonia-1 is the first dedicated commercial mission of NewSpace India Limited (NSIL), a Government of India company under Department of Space. NSIL is undertaking this mission under a commercial arrangement with Spaceflight Inc., the USA.

Amazonia-1 is the

optical earth observation satellite of National Institute for Space Research (INPE).

This satellite will further strengthen the existing structure by providing remote sensing data to users for monitoring deforestation in the

Amazon region and analysis of diversified agriculture across the Brazilian territory, ISRO said.

The 20 co-passenger satellites include one from ISRO (INS-2TD), 'Anand', 'Satish Dhawan' satellite and 'UNITYsat'.

'India-Bangladesh model of regional bilateral ties'

New Delhi, Feb. 6: The relationship between India and Bangladesh has withstood the test of time and both countries have charted a unique model for regional cooperation that is quite unparalleled in South Asia, Foreign Secretary Harsh Vardhan Shringla said on Friday.

He said both the countries have been blessed with history, culture, language and above all an ardent belief in freedom, justice and pluralism, and described the commonalities as the "bridge" to a future of peace and prosperity.

Shringla was speaking at the inaugural function of the third Bangladesh film festival in Kolkata. "India and Bangladesh have together charted

a unique model for regional cooperation, quite unparalleled in South Asia," he said.

"The India-Bangladesh bilateral relationship has withstood the test of time, and even as the world undergoes great upheaval in the post-pandemic era, our relationship grows from strength to strength," Shringla said.

The foreign secretary also mentioned the robust exchanges that both sides had in recent months including his two visits to Dhaka, notwithstanding the coronavirus pandemic.

"Cooperation is moving forward inexorably. Our prime minister is looking forward to his visit to Dhaka," he said.

Prime Minister

Narendra Modi is scheduled to travel to Dhaka in March. Bangladesh Foreign Secretary Masud Bin Momen visited India last month to prepare ground for Modi's visit to that country.

In his address, the foreign secretary referred to the historical bond between the two nations while delving into the Bangladesh liberation war.

"I say it with great pride that the deep historical bond between our two nations has been etched in golden letters with the blood of our soldiers. It was protected and preserved by the sheer determination of our peoples," he said.
